The Endowment Committee's Evening of Love & Laughter Fundraiser will be held on Saturday, February 9th.

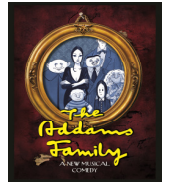

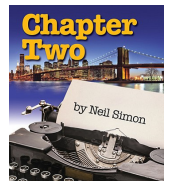
