Because this is a different venue and we are in the middle of a pandemic, there are some significant differences.

- Ticket prices will be raised to \$18 while at this venue. They will return to our usual prices when we can return to TNT.
- The theater will open 1.5 hours (6:30 and 11:30) before curtain to allow ample time for everyone to clear the entrance, have their temperature checked, and find socially distanced seats.
- Everyone will need reservations. No walk-ins, no tickets sold at the door.
- Speaking of socially distanced seats, the seating is “general admission” meaning that there are no assigned seats. If you want a particular seat, come early. The seats around those your party selects will be tagged as closed to reinforce the distance required.
- We will be using a full sound system so the sound will carry well throughout the entire auditorium. Also the stage is raised quite a bit more than at TNT so consider that when selecting your seats.
- There is significant parking around the area of the theater within easy walking distance. The lot immediately adjacent the theater will be reserved for the handicapped (*you must have a valid hang tag or license plate indicating such*).
- The parking places in front of the theater will be blocked off to allow drop off and pickup.
- There will be a shuttle running from The Sunrise Inn to the theater if you’d like to eat there before the show. There are many restaurants within walking distance of the theater, check about reservations and make sure you allow time to make the curtain.
- Warren PD will be visible and vigilant. They do a fine job of protecting our area.

Please be assured that this change of venue is temporary. It benefits both TNT and The Robins. This is a wonderful collaborative solution for both organizations. We have a show with no viable theatre and The Robins has a large theatre but no show.

That said, we do not know how things will progress. We are still in the midst of a pandemic and may continue staging more of our planned season in partnership with The Robins.
