The 2019-2020 comes with exciting new options for your season tickets!

OPTION 1: Like the way things run now? Then the REGULAR SEASON PASS is for you! Everything will run as it has in the past. This is the perfect option for people whose lives change from month to month making it hard to plan too far in advance. You will need to make your reservation as each opening night approaches. The advanced reservation window will open on the Monday two weeks prior to opening night at 7pm. You will be able to call Monday thru Thursday, 7pm to 9pm or you can go online 24/7 at www.trumbullnewtheatre.tix.com for the run of the show to make your reservation.

OPTION 2: Have trouble remembering to make the call for your reservations? Our PREMIUM PACKAGES may be right for you! Pick your show night and seats when you pay for your season pass!

You will need to specify what show night you want – which weekend, which night – and indicate your seating preference. These seats will be assigned on a first come basis among those purchasing the PREMIUM PACKAGES. If someone beats you to your exact seating choice, you will be called to make another selection. So book early and guarantee your favorite seat!

But what if something comes up? Worried about committing to shows that far in advance? We all know that life changes. If you find that you cannot attend on the night you selected, you must call us or email: webmaster@trumbullnewtheatre.com during advanced sale week (two weeks prior to opening) to change performance dates (*your exact seat selection will probably NOT be available for the new night*). Only ONE change per show will be permitted.

ALSO NEW THIS YEAR (for option 1 or option 2): We will be taking your credit card if you would prefer to pay that way (additional fees will apply). You need to email our webmaster (webmaster@trumbullnewtheatre.com) with the best times to call you and one of our volunteers will call you and finalize everything. You will need to have all the information on the form ready as well as your credit card to complete the sale.

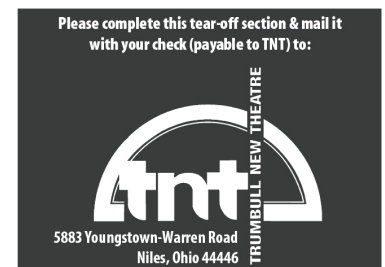

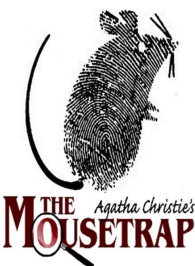
THE FOX ON THE FAIRWAY

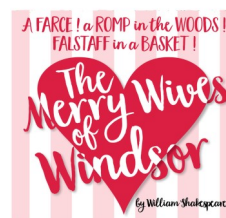
THE MERRY WIVES OF WINDSOR
